MLA uses a left-indented topper for the paper author's name, the professor's name, the course name, and date, while MLA and Chicago style do not.

Paragraph begins below levels 1 and 2, whereas for levels 3-5, the paragraph begins in line with the headings. Capitalize each word for levels 1 and 2. For levels 3-5, the headings are indented and end with a period. Only the first word is capitalized for levels 3-5.

According to APA rules, the title that appears in the header of your cover page (Running head: TITLE) and subsequent pages (TITLE) cannot exceed 50 characters including spaces and punctuation. In addition, it is recommended that titles never exceed twelve words. When the title is more than 50 characters, titles should be shortened.

Note: All citations should be double spaced and have a hanging indent in a Reference List. A "hanging indent" means that each subsequent line after the first line of your citation should be indented by 0.5 inches.
