For the first year at least, allow all the branches with foliage to remain; the more branches the tree has, the more carbohydrates it will make

Evergreens generally have a longer pruning season than deciduous plants. In addition to early spring and midsummer, pruning after new growth has hardened is acceptable for pines and spruce trees. Juniperus spp. - junipers and Thuja spp. - arborvitae can be pruned up to mid-August.

Prune a newly planted tree for the first year, unless you are removing dead or broken branches. Prune within 10 feet of a utility conductor - leave it to the pros. Try to tackle a pruning job that requires a chain saw and ladder work - leave it to the pros. Leave branch stubs, or cut off the branch collar (not make a flush cut).

A young, healthy tree can tolerate a pruning dose of around 50 percent, while healthy trees in their 20s to 40s (depending on how long they may live) tolerate a dose of about 25 percent, and old trees in good health can stand no more than 10 percent.

Pruning is an essential gardening skill. When you prune correctly, you encourage healthy growth and flowering (in the case of flowering plants), as well as good looks. For most shrubs and trees, it helps to prune at the right time. Some are best pruned in winter; some right after flowering.

Most walnut trees establish their shape early and do not need to be pruned regularly after their first few years of growth. The best time to prune a young walnut is in the early spring, before the growing season begins. The ideal time for pruning can vary according to species, as well as on the reason for pruning. However, here are some general guidelines: Dead and diseased branches should be removed as soon as possible. A good time to prune trees and shrubs is late-winter/early-spring - when buds begin to open.

This helps defend against the spread of the pest and prevent further damage. Also, pruning can increase the vitality of the plant to improve flowering and fruit production.

Tree Pruning Essentials - Purdue Extension

Generally speaking, the following criteria should apply: Evergreen trees - Pruning of evergreen tree is recommended to be done just before spring due to faster healing in the coming growing season. Deciduous Trees - Pruning of deciduous trees is recommended to be done in winter as trees are in the dormant state.

Aesthetics - Pruning a tree effectively helps to maintain its shape and appearance. However, you shouldn't try to impose an unnatural shape or size on a tree. The amount of trimming and pruning that will be needed could seriously damage it. Safety - Dead or broken branches and limbs can fall off at any time, which is a serious safety hazard.

Prune annually to keep the tree healthy, productive and looking its best. It can take 3 to 10 years for trees to begin flowering and producing fruit. Mature pear trees are large and produce a lot of fruit in a short window of time. Fruit should be picked at a mature stage and then allowed to ripen indoors.
